

NOTICE TO STAKEHOLDERS

FACILITATION OF EXPORTS UNDER THE AGREEMENT ESTABLISHING THE AFRICAN CONTINENTAL FREE TRADE AREA (AfCFTA)

The Kingdom of Eswatini, as a member of the African Union (AU), has concluded and deposited instruments of ratification of the African Continental Free Trade Agreement (AfCFTA) scheduled to enter into force on 1st January 2021.

By virtue of being a State Party to this Agreement, the Kingdom of Eswatini has an obligation to implement the AfCFTA. This, therefore, serves as notice that all persons interested in exporting goods into the AfCFTA are required to be registered as exporters by the Eswatini Revenue Authority, being the designated issuing authority for Certificates of Origin under all trade agreements to which Eswatini is a party.
